Who we are...

The Aurora Teen Pregnancy and Prevention Project (ATP3) has been serving teens in Aurora since 1994. One of five sites originally funded by The Colorado Trust's "Teen Pregnancy Prevention 2000 Initiative," the program works on **PREVENTING** teen pregnancies, **EDUCATING** about teen-related health issues and **SUPPORTING** teens who are pregnant and/or parenting.

Our Mission:

To improve and protect the emotional, physical and sexual health of young people through confidential case management, support groups, parenting classes, the Teen Clinic and community advocacy.



What we do...

On the **PREVENTION** side, we offer a comprehensive program called "It Takes Two" to middle and high school students. The program focuses on helping students understand healthy relationships, responsible decision making, the realities around STDs/STIs and the financial and emotional impact of becoming a teen parent.

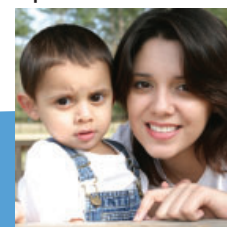
Our **TEEN CLINIC** provides confidential, low-cost family planning-related services to males and females ages 11-19. The clinic serves teens from both inside and outside the Denver metro area. For more information on the Teen Clinic, please call their MESSAGE AND INFORMATION LINE at 303-637-3235

ATP3 Staff give **EDUCATIONAL TRAININGS** on various topics including birth control options, STDs and STIs, healthy relationships, teen pregnancy and teen parenting.

On the **SUPPORTING SIDE**, ATP3 offers **CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES** to pregnant and/or parenting teens ages 11-19 who live in Aurora or unincorporated Arapahoe County. The ultimate goal is to improve teens' relationships with others including their children and help them become self-sufficient. Case management services are also available for Spanish-speaking teens.

SUPPORT GROUPS help create a safe setting for pregnant and parenting teens in Aurora to meet and receive support, education and information in their school or community setting.

PARENTING CLASSES specifically for teen parents help them acquire skills on reading their baby's cues, understanding infant development and learning age-appropriate activities to encourage their baby's growth.
